Mobile Therapist

Mobile Therapist will work under the direction of the Clinical Director and in collaboration with other members of the treatment team. They design and implement a treatment plan suitable to each individual client and family with identified goals and interventions to address identified emotional needs of the child, adolescent and youth in therapy sessions in the home or identified community location to allow for more flexibility in service delivery. Services are not to be provided in an office setting. Services provided by the MT are intended to be strengths-based, child-centered, and family-focused, using therapeutic techniques to address the Medically Necessary Targeted Needs identified in the Written Order by a Licensed Psychologist, Psychiatrist or other Licensed Mental Health Provider. MT will maintain licensure if relevant, attend required trainings and supervision, and complete all relevant documentation.

Requirements:

- Must have PA Criminal, PA Child Abuse and FBI Clearances indicating no past infractions
- Must have completed the Mandated Reporter Training
- Be licensed in this Commonwealth as a psychologist, professional counselor, marriage and family therapist or clinical social worker
- Be licensed in this Commonwealth as a social worker or a behavior specialist and have a graduate degree that required clinical or mental health direct service practicum
- Have a minimum of 1 year of full-time experience in providing mental health direct services to children, youth or young adults and a graduate degree in psychology, social work, education, or counseling, with at least nine credits specific to clinical practice in psychology, social work or counseling

• Completed a clinical or mental health direct service practicum and have a graduate degree with at least nine credits specific to clinical practice in psychology, social work, education, counseling or a related field. Coursework must include different therapy approaches including training in the diagnostic criteria of mental and behavioral health disorders as well as training in conducting mental health assessments.
